Easter is here!

And, as Christians all over the world will echo ... 'HE IS RISEN!' This year—on Easter morning, we're starting a brand new worship series called: GOD LOVES YOU—despite your past, wherever you go, right where you are. And that, folks, is the Good News of Easter! And that is a message so many in our world need to hear today—right now!

So, how much does God love you? I don't know of one single individual on the face of this earth that doesn't want to (or need to) know they're loved! We live in a tough world that is not always open to loving others, to handing life issues in a loving way, to leading in a loving way. But we believe that's God's way. Because that's been the example before us. God loves us and expects us to love others in turn—a love that comes from thankful hearts.

Some may be asking, what are we supposed to be thankful for? The fact is, before Jesus, we were lost—eternally. Our relationship with God had been torn in two. In Hebrews 2:14-15 (NLT) we're reminded: "Because God's children are human beings—made of flesh and blood—the Son also became flesh and blood. For only as a human being could he die, and only by dying could he break the power of the devil, who had the power of death. ¹⁵ Only in this way could he set free all who have lived their lives as slaves to the fear of dying." What an incredible gift! But, it cost God the life of his only son. God loves us that much! And Easter is the story of the power of the devil, the power of death, being broken. What incredible Good News!

This ol' world can be very unforgiving at times. So, how 'bout a God who both loves and forgives—doing something so amazing that we might be forgiven! It's an incredible story ... and it's the Easter story. We start on Easter morning, then continue learning about the extent of God's love for the next seven weeks after Easter. Again, who doesn't want to know they're loved? That's what you're going to be hearing about on Easter and beyond.

So, if you—or any one you know—needs to know that they are loved, Trinity UMC will be the place to be on Easter and several weeks thereafter. In June, I was privileged to return to Bolivia for the 5th Disabilities Conference. The attendance was amazing with over 150 teachers, social workers and nursing students present. They even came early and stayed until the final minutes! When we began the conferences, Bolivian teachers, who had no training in mainstreaming special needs students, were facing the daunting task of integrating them into the classroom and providing a good education for both the special needs children and the remainder of the class. And there was not a lot of interest. Now we find



that interest is high and the number of special needs options is growing.



We visited the Walter Henry Educational Complex (Advance #12320A) for the morning assembly and for the celebration of the school's Birthday. There are 250 students this year and there is a lot of work being done on the school facilities. We would like to organize a VIM team to work with upkeep, construction and possibly teaching. Your continued support of the Advance helps make this quality Christian education possible. Thank you!

I enjoy traveling. I flew to Amsterdam with a college classmate and we began a Rhine River cruise. I can't tell you much about the cruise - saw no castles nor mountains- but there is an excellent hospital in Koblenz, Germany, where I had an emergency appendectomy! All turned out well and we spent an extra week in the Netherlands.
