## “REST...”

The LORD is my shepherd; I have all that I need. <sup>2</sup> He lets me rest in green meadows; he leads me beside peaceful streams. <sup>3</sup> He renews my strength. He guides me along right paths, bringing honor to his name. – Psalm 23:1-3 (NLT)

Dear Trinity family,

Summer is here! I don't know about you, but I love summers in Wisconsin. After having traveled over much of these United States and several parts of the world, it is always good to be in Wisconsin in the summer. It is absolutely beautiful. And summer is a time for family, too. That's why I like Wisconsin summers. I have a brother who lives on a lake and we have family gatherings there. What great memories. What great family times of gathering and of ... rest...

I don't know about you, but the twenty-third Psalm (above) is one of my favorites. And I'm especially thinking about Verse 2 as we enter into these summer months, as King David expresses his joy in how God cares for him. “He lets me rest in green meadows; he leads me beside peaceful streams.” If you know anything about the land where David lived, you'll know that both these things—green meadows and peaceful streams—are uncommon. There are very few places in Israel—even today—that I would consider ‘green.’ And there are even fewer ‘peaceful streams’ as water sources like that are scarce in Israel. But God provided for King David. And in the same way, God will provide the rest you and I need this summer, too.

Sometimes, rest is just a matter of a change of schedule or scenery. Have you noticed that? Just as a reminder, *we've changed our summer worship schedule to one service at 9 AM on Sunday mornings*. It'll be different, but I'm thinking ... ‘restfully’ so. And, wow, does Wisconsin have the scenery we can enjoy; much of it is green ... and we are plentiful in the area of ‘peaceful streams’ too.

So, here's what I'm telling you: enjoy! Enjoy the changes—all the changes—that summer brings. Get rested. Get refreshed. The work we do here at Trinity is *eternally* important—not just for today, but for all eternity. We need to be rested for the new school year of ministry that will begin in September. So, *enjoy the one worship service this summer*. Enjoy as much Wisconsin beauty as you can. And let's be ready to do ministry together come fall. I love you all enough to tell you ... take care of yourselves—in every way! And take care of your families; they are gifts from God...

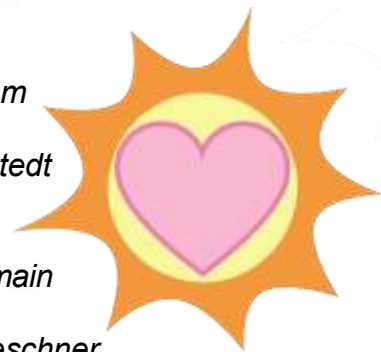

## Caring Ministry

**Do you feel a calling to serve Trinity members who are home bound or reside in nursing homes? If so, there is still time to join Trinity's Caring Ministry Team!**

**Interested individuals are asked to sign your name to the Caring Ministry sign up sheet in the Connections Room. You may also contact Kathy Drexler at 583-3551 ASAP. Training for this ministry begins soon.**

Here are the expectations for caring ministers:

1. Attend two required training session: June 13 and July 11.
  - Both begin at 6:30 and will be run by Pastor Rom. Plan on 90 minute sessions.
  - The June 13 session is for new recruits only.
  - The entire team (new recruits and veterans) will meet on July 11.
2. At the end of the July 11 meeting volunteers will be asked to sign a one year covenant.
  - The commitment extends from September 2018 through August 2019
3. Following a background check, each team member will be paired with a care receiver.
4. We would like for you to meet with your care receiver at least once a month.
  - The day and time of that meeting can be at your convenience.
  - A brief monthly report form will be completed to alert the pastor to any critical needs of the care receiver.
5. There will be three "Check In" meetings throughout the year to deal with anything that may arise.

**The veteran team members will tell you that we probably receive more than we give in this ministry. Our care receivers are very appreciative to have a monthly visit from someone connected to Trinity UMC. Our "shut-ins" still care deeply for their church and the congregation.**
