I sincerely want to know of any pastoral needs you have.

On Sunday, October 03, 2021, I will introduce a series of messages on "Prayer" focused on the Lord's Prayer from Matthew 6:9-13.

As we all know, the Lord's Prayer is one of the world's most famous Christian prayers, authored by Christ himself. However, it is worth noting that Jesus was never actually recorded as praying this prayer. He delivered these words as a model on prayer for his disciples: "This, then, is how you should pray: "Our Father..."

So, to pray the way our Lord taught us, we will need to attend to the meaning behind the words, rather than simply repeating or reciting them. Through the following six weeks of our sermon series, we will sightsee the different elements of the Lord's Prayer, with its opening adoration of the Lord, followed by its seven petitions. Here are the messages you can expect in October:

October 03: Lord, Teach Us to Pray, Luke 11:1; Matthew 6:9-13

October 10: Holy Is Our Father's Name, Matthew 6:9

October 17: Expectation and Submission, Matthew 6:10

October 24: Praying for Provision, Mathew 6:11

October 31: Confession and Compassion, Matthew 6:12; 14-15

You are all invited to come and explore what the Lord has prepared for us. Please, invite at least one person every week to come and taste.

I look forward to doing ministry together with you!


