# DISAFFILIATION INFORMATION

There haven't been many announcements or meetings about our disaffiliation from the United Methodist Church and alignment with the Global Methodist Church, but there is much going on behind-the-scenes!

- **+John Muentner** is managing our application to the Global Methodist Church. This has been submitted and under review. Pastor Mulongo Mpoyo has also submitted his application to the GMC; his intention is to stay with our congregation in Lomira.
- **+Kathy and Pete Drexler** are managing the legalities, along with our partnership with the National Center for Life and Liberty, an organization helping many UM churches with their disaffiliation. We are now incorporated with the State of Wisconsin. By-laws have been reviewed and closely align with those of the Global Methodist Church. Our local church governance basically remains the same.
- +The Disaffiliation Agreement with the Wisconsin Conference also has been reviewed by the National Center for Life and Liberty with no "red flags". One item that we were previously unaware of is an adjustment we'll need to make to our liability insurance coverage. There are discussions happening with other disaffiliating churches in Wisconsin to get a group discount along with the changes we need. The Agreement has been sent to the Conference office as well as our "disaffiliation fees" of \$181,734.26.
- **+Sandy Porter** is managing the historical archives project. We are required to send all originals of our church archives such as the rolls of marriage, deaths and membership. Since we want to preserve that history for ourselves, copies will be made of all records before they are given to the Conference.
- **+Bill Buske** is collecting pledges for the disaffiliation fees that we will incur. Talk with Pam, Bill, or Jill Franklin in the office, if you need the form to complete. No money is due at this time, and payments can be made on your time schedule over the next year.
- **+John Lavarda** is managing an application for a Covid-related benefit that is still available; it is based on how our "business operation" was affected by Covid. While not specifically related to disaffiliation, it may be a few thousand dollars to help our overall budget.

#### PRAYER!

While we believe that the 44 Wisconsin churches will be allowed to leave the UMC, by simple majority vote at Annual Conference in Green Bay on June 9<sup>th</sup>, many of us are still feeling cautious. We need to continue to call on God to move in the hearts of everyone voting on that Friday afternoon. We call on God to know that are efforts are in the name of Jesus and our desire to hold the Bible as Truth for all people, over all time.

Please pray also for your delegates, Kathy Drexler and Pam Wellso, as we consider all legislation presented at the conference for voting. Pray for Mulongo and Tshishinen as they also participate and vote. Pray for Mulongo and Tshishinen as they look for the best options for their ministry as pastors and as a family.

We have worked mighty hard over the last several years to affect this exciting change for our congregation. I personally have been thrilled to be part of this history while at the same time, some you know, I'm tired! I look forward to what our church can do in the future to bless God and his people in our congregation, the community, and the world.


